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## SIGNS OF STROKE

A sudden onset of the following may indicate stroke

01



Sudden weakness of the face, arm, or leg, especially on one side of the body, might be a sign of stroke.

02



A sudden feeling of numbness in the body, such as the face, arm, or leg might be a sign of stroke.

03



A person who suddenly begins to have trouble walking might be experiencing stroke.

04



A person who experiences sudden vision changes, blurred vision, or trouble with eyesight in one or both eyes might be experiencing stroke.

05



A person who experiences a sudden onset of dizziness might be experiencing stroke.

06



A sudden onset of severe headache that has no known cause might be a sign of stroke.

07



A sudden onset of confusion might be a sign of stroke.

08



A person who exhibits a sudden inability to speak or slurred speech might be experiencing stroke.

09



A sudden difficulty in understanding speech, interaction with others, might be a sign of stroke.

10



A person who is exhibiting sudden loss in balance and coordination might be experiencing stroke.
